### CACFP Grant ~

You may be wondering why some of GPCP educators and Farm to School coordinators have been wearing hair nets these days. This is because we finally got approved for the Child and Adult Care & Food Program (CACFP). The CACFP is a federally-funded program administered by Bright from the Start. The Grant provides reimbursement for nutritious meals served to children in child care centers.

If you have been at GPCP for a few years, you probably know that we have been trying to get this grant for quite some time. It was an arduous process that required a complex application and we had to undergo a successful pre-operational visit. Going forward, we must comply with federal and state regulations/guidance and maintain adequate records to support the monthly claims for meal reimbursement and other costs charged to the program.



I am very proud of our accomplishment. It was a tremendous effort led by our fabulous Assistant Director, Ms. Qiana Suggs in collaboration with Taylor Mead and Ina Musgrove, Farm to School coordinators from their respective campus. I extend my sincere appreciation to each one of them!
