



SCHOOL AGE Summer Camp 2017

New this Year: Lego Camps!

GPCP will be offering summer camps for school age children at our Cabbagetown Campus. Summer camps for preschool age children will be offered at the Grant Park Campus as usual.

Registration begins February 2nd until full.

Summer camp is "first-come/first-served". Please make your plans accordingly.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- School Age Summer Camp is structured into **seven- one week sessions**.
- Children may sign up for as many of the sessions offered.
- Lego Camps: we will offer two Lego Camps during the same week, a morning camp and an afternoon camp. Both camps will be offered at the Cabbagetown Campus.
- A non-refundable payment of the first full session per child is due at the time of registration. This payment serves as the deposit. FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT.
- The remaining balance is due by June 5th, 2017 (Please note: School will be closed from May 29th to June 2nd and the office will reopen on June 5th).
- Children who are new to GPCP must pay a nonrefundable registration fee of \$50 per child in addition to the session fees listed below.

SUMMER CAMP HOURS

Morning Camps from 9:00 am to 1:00

Early Arrival hours (7:30 am to 9:00 am) & Extended Day hours (1:00 pm to 6:00 pm) are offered at an extra cost of \$6/hour for prepaid OR \$8.00/hour if not prepaid. The monthly prepaid form is due on the 25th of the previous month (Thursday, May 25th for June Prepaid).

SNACK AND LUNCH: A healthy snack will be provided by the school.

Please pack a healthy and nutritious lunch for your child each day. GPCP is a NUT FREE environment. NO NUTS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED on campus.

RESCHEDULING AND CANCELLATION: Please take into consideration the following policies when changing your date(s)/session(s) or canceling your registration.

- **Session Changes:** Changes to sessions must be emailed with at least two weeks notice prior to the beginning of the first session enrolled. The following are the deadlines for changes by session: Session I: May 22nd - Session II: May 29th - Session III: June 5th - Session IV: June 12th - Session V: June 19th - Session VI: July 3rd - Session VII: July 10th

- **Cancellations and Refunds:** Cancellations made by June 5th, 2017 are eligible for a 50% refund, except for the deposit which is non-refundable (payment of the first session).

There will be no refunds for Summer Camp after June 5th, 2017.

SESSION DATES AND CAMP OPTION (Rising Kindergarteners up to 11years old)**Session I : June 5 - June 9*****Farm to Table
Laboratory***

Enter the food laboratory! Children will experiment with taste, aroma, aesthetics of presentation, nutrition, cooking and some countertop kitchen science. We will create recipes for new and interesting breads, salads, pasta dishes, beverages, summer treats and cool eats. Come prepared for a culinary adventure. It's going to get messy!

Swim Camp

Swim lessons will be offered by a certified swim instructor from the City of Atlanta and children will be supervised by our own GPCP educators. Before or after the swim lessons, the children will enjoy sports, games and a picnic lunch in the park. Swimmers bring their own sack lunch each day. Remember, no nuts, please!

Session II: June 12 - June 16***LEGO CAMPS
Morning & Afternoon

Children will be exposed to the concept of repurposing materials, converting waste materials into beautiful things through the language of sewing, one of earth's oldest human material languages. Children will express themselves by creating clothing, jewelry, and accessories with found objects while being environmentally conscious.

Session IV: June 26 – June 30***The Ultimate

Campers love challenges! Behold, the mystery food challenge! Would you dare drink the weird green concoctions? The obstacle course challenge! Can you navigate the course without popping your water balloon?

Session V: July 10 – 14 (No School Age Camps - July 3 – 7)***Sustainable
Art Camp***

For this camp, we will invite the children to create works of art with reclaimed and natural materials. We will explore the process of making natural dyes for painting and weaving with natural materials such as flowers, sticks, and grass and experiment with loose parts and recycled materials to create sculptures and collage pieces.

Session VI: July 17 - July 21***Spanish Camp I***

GPCP's Spanish educator will lead this Spanish immersion camp inspired by classic and familiar children's stories *Where the Wild Things Are* & *GPCP's Mud Monster Folklore*. Following the book's theme, children will learn vocabulary related to the language and concepts within the stories. Children will have opportunities to design and create a paper lantern to represent a character from these stories.
