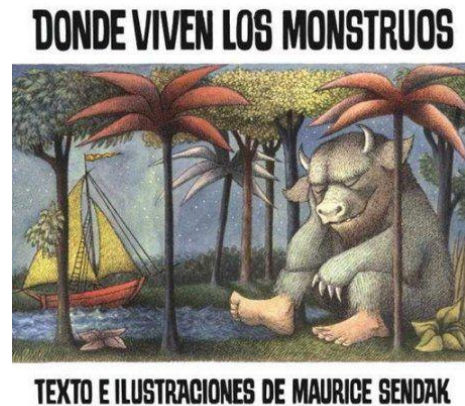


**Welcome to Spanish Camp Session I 2017!**  
**“Donde Viven Los Monstruos”**  
**(Where the Wild Things Are)**



La señora Clara Castillo, GPCP's Spanish Educator, will be leading this Spanish immersion camp (both sessions). The camp is inspired by classic and traditional stories like "Donde viven los Monstruos" (Where the Wild Things are) and GPCP's Folklore stories of "El Monstruo de Barro" (The Mud Monster). Children will have lots of fun with the stories at the same time they are learning vocabulary related to the language and concepts of these stories. She will introduce new vocabulary such as lobo (wolf), travesuras (pranks), bosque: woods/forest, crecer (to grow), colgar(to hang), entrar (entering), saltarse (jumping) rugir (to roar) crujir (to croak/cackle/crunch/grind), garra (claw), truco (trick). Children will also have an opportunity to design and create a paper lantern representing a character from these stories.
