



SCHOOL AGE Summer Camp 2019

Lego Camps coming back this year!

GPCP will be offering summer camps for school age children at our Cabbagetown Campus.

Summer camps for preschool age children will be offered at both Campuses.

Registration begins February 12nd until full.

Summer camp is “first-come/first-served”. Please make your plans accordingly.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- School Age Summer Camp is structured into **seven- one week sessions**.
- Children may sign up for as many of the sessions offered.
- Swim Camp: GPCP Staff will transport children from the Grant Park pool to the Extended Day program at the Cabbagetown Campus.
- We will offer three Lego Engineering Camps:
 - Two camps during the week of June 10 - June 14 (morning & afternoon)
Children can participate in one or the other, or both camps by paying both fees. A child who only signs up for the morning camp, can still participate in the GPCP Extended Day Program (additional fee)
Children who are enrolled in the Swim Camp in the mornings, can also sign up for the afternoon LEGO camp.
 - One camp during the week of July 15 - July 19 (morning only). A child who signs up for the morning camp, can still participate in the GPCP Extended Day Program (additional fee)
- A non-refundable payment of the first full session per child is due at the time of registration. This payment serves as the deposit. **FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT.**
- The remaining balance is due by June 3, 2019 (Please note: School will be closed from May 27th to May 31st and the office will reopen on June 3rd).
- Children who are new to GPCP must pay a nonrefundable registration fee of \$50 per child in addition to the session fees listed below.

SUMMER CAMP HOURS

Morning Camps from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm

Early Arrival hours (7:30 am to 9:00 am) & Extended Day hours (1:00 pm to 6:00 pm) are offered at an extra cost of \$6/hour if prepaid OR \$8.00/hour if not prepaid. June’s prepaid form and payment will be due on Thursday, May 24th.

SNACK AND LUNCH: A healthy snack will be provided by the school.

Please pack a healthy and nutritious lunch for your child each day. GPCP is a NUT FREE environment. **NO NUTS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED on campus.**

RESCHEDULING AND CANCELLATION: Please take into consideration the following policies when changing your date(s)/session(s) or canceling your registration.

- **Session Changes:** Changes to sessions must be emailed with at least two weeks notice prior to the beginning of the first session enrolled. The following are the deadlines for changes by session: Session I: May 20th - Session II: May 27th - Session III: June 3rd - Session IV: June 10th - Session V: June 24th - Session VI: July 1st - Session VII: July 8th

- **Cancellations and Refunds:** Cancellations made by May 20th, 2019 are eligible for a 50% refund, except for the deposit which is non-refundable (payment of the first session).

There will be no refunds for Summer Camp after May 20, 2019.

SESSION DATES AND CAMP OPTION (Rising Kindergarteners up to 11 years old)**Session I : June 3 - June 7*****Sustainable Art Camp***

We will invite the children to create works of art with reclaimed and natural materials. We will explore the process of making natural dyes for painting and weaving with natural materials such as flowers, sticks, and grass and experiment with loose parts and recycled materials to create sculptures and collage pieces.

Swim Camp I

Swim lessons will be offered by a certified swim instructor from the City of Atlanta and children will be supervised by our own GPCP educators. Before or after the swim lessons, the children will enjoy sports, games and a picnic lunch in the park. Swimmers bring their own sack lunch each day. **No nuts, please!**

Session II: June 10 - June 14***LEGO Camps Morning and Afternoon***
